Directions to Bear Creek Scout Reservation

Take Interstate 10 North through Kerrville. Exit at **FM 781** (Harper exit); go around cloverleaf to head **south**. Go South on FM 783 until it ends at State Highway 27. Turn **right** onto **State Highway 27** and follow it to **Ingram**. At the "Y", veer **left** onto **State Highway 39**. Take State Highway 39 to **Hunt**. At the edge of Hunt, turn **right** onto **FM 1340**. Follow FM 1340 to Bear Creek Scout Reservation, which will be on the right. All the roads are marked, but the roads do twist and turn, so watch for the signs carefully.

Liquid fuels for lantern may not be stored at campsite because of fire hazard. No campfires are permitted by camp participants. Vehicles can only park in designated areas. Any parking exceptions need to be cleared with the Council Office prior to camp. Youth protection policies of the Boy Scouts of America do not allow parents to share a tent with any youngster except their own son.
