GUIDELINES FOR USE OF COUNCIL CANOES

1. Reservation must be made through council office 3 weeks prior to activity, first come, first served. Canoes will be picked up at McGimsey Scout Park . Council cannot ferry canoes to your pick up location. **You will be contacted if there is a scheduling problem.**
2. Canoes are rented only in **full loads** of 6 canoes per trailer, 12 paddles and 12 PFD'S. *No partial load or single rentals.*
3. The unit is responsible for the cost of repair or replacement of any equipment that is lost, stolen or returned in damaged condition.
4. Readiness fee (non refundable) of \$15.00 will be deducted from your fees if you do not pick up your canoes as indicated.
5. Cost is \$100.00 per trailer load, per day. A refundable deposit of \$100.00 will be required along with the reservation fee. All fees should be paid at service center and receipt presented to Ranger at pick up.
6. The BSA Safe Swim Defense and Safety Afloat guidelines must be followed. A Float Plan should be left with a person **not** attending your outing and their name should appear on this form. A **FLOAT PLAN AND TOUR PERMIT MUST ALSO BE FILED WITH ALAMO AREA COUNCIL PRIOR TO YOUR OUTING.** Exact itinerary (including launch points, stops, estimated travel time, breaks etc.) must be documented on the back of this form. Emergency contact must also be recorded.
7. One leader must be CPR certified, one leader or older scout must be BSA Lifeguard certified.
8. **ALL ABOVE MENTIONED CERTIFICATION CARDS MUST BE CURRENT AND BE PRESENTED TO THE RANGER BEFORE THE CANOES CAN BE CHECKED OUT.**
9. Canoes are not available in June and July, due to summer camp usage.
10. The towing vehicle should be equipped with a 2" ball and a 4-wire flat trailer light connector. The person towing the canoes is responsible for proper and safe towing of the trailer.
11. Pick up between noon and 6:00 p.m. on day specified and return by 1:00 p.m. Sunday, if rental is on a weekend.
