1. Selection of the adult is based upon ability to perform the necessary functions and not for recognition of service, including current or prior achievement and position.
 2. The adult will be an asset to the Order due to demonstrated skills and abilities, which fulfill the purpose of the Order.
 3. The camping requirements that apply for youth candidates apply to adult candidates and must have been fulfilled within the most recent two years prior to recommendation for membership. The requirement, which is a minimum of fifteen days and nights of camping under the auspices and standards of the Boy Scouts of America, including **ONE, but no more than one**, long-term camp consisting of **SIX consecutive days and FIVE nights**. The balance of the camping must be overnight, weekend, or other short-term camps. **For Adults in District and Council positions, this requirement may be waived at the discretion of the Lodge Adviser and the Scout Executive.**
 4. The adult's membership will provide a positive role model for the growth and development of the youth members of the lodge.
