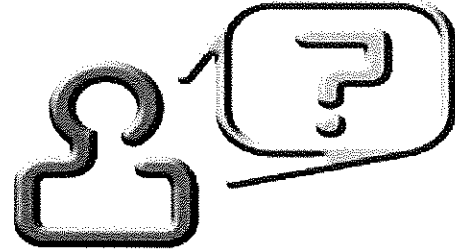


I volunteered. What do I do now? Attend Roundtable!

Space is available to Scouts and adults interested in being part of our Council Contingent going to Philmont from 6/14-6/27 2012. Come join us and be part of a Great Adventure!

Our cost covers Philmont's fees and transportation for everyone. We also include a polo, hat and patch. Applications are processed on a first come first serve basis. A waiting list has been established on applications.

We usually get participants who drop out during the year so it is likely that you will have the opportunity to go to Philmont with the Council Contingent. A full crew consists of 12 participants going as a trek. It could be 4 adults and 8 youth for example. If you are willing to go you will be placed with a troop who does not have a full crew.

Scout Requirements: Must be a registered Boy Scout, Venture, Varsity or Post member and be at least 14 years of age as of January 1, 2012 or completed the 8th grade at time of attendance and be at least 13 years of age and meet the Dietary Guidelines for height and weight recommendations from the U.S. Department of Agriculture. A copy of the guidelines is available with the Council receptionist.

Fees: The 2012 Philmont Contingent Fee for Scout or Scouter is \$1400. Payment due now is \$600. The next payments of \$400 each are due: November 15, 2011 and January 16, 2012. **A Scout who drops forfeits all fees paid to date.** A direct replacement from your unit can replace you with no forfeiture of fees. Applications are processed on a first come first serve basis.

If you would like to serve as an Adult leader (Trek Advisor) for one of our Council Contingent Treks at Philmont Scout Ranch in 2012, please complete the following information listed below about yourself and return this application to the Council Service Center (McGimsey Scout Park) with the Philmont nonrefundable \$200.00 deposit fee. Please bring your application and deposit to the registration desk to receive your paid receipt. Crew size will be 12 campers. Crews having less than 12 campers will be assigned additional campers to bring your total to 12 campers whenever possible. Crews are limited to four (4) adults. **A camper who drops forfeits all fees paid to date.** You may directly replace a camper within a unit with no additional chargers.

Your deposit will remain attached to your applications for 2 weeks until the council has processed your application. An acceptable application is based on space availability and meeting the current Dietary Guidelines for Americans from the U.S. Department of Agriculture for height and weight recommendations. A copy of these guidelines is available from the registration file folder located in the council service center reception area.

Arrival date at Philmont is June 14, 2012 and returning June 27, 2012. 57 campers will be arriving on the Council Bus on this date.

Applications are being accepted on a first come first serve basis. When the applications exceed our 57 scouts and advisor limit, your deposit will be returned to your attention and your application retained as a possible replacement for another adult. Whenever possible, the Advisors with scouts from the same unit will be kept together on the same crew. One or two others from your district or an adjacent district may join your crew. To ensure the scouts will have a successful high adventure, one advisor per crew should have a Philmont experience or equivalent. Deadline for applications with \$200 nonrefundable deposits is August 15, 2011.

The 2012 Philmont Contingent Fee for Scouts or Scouters is \$1400. One-Third payments of \$400 are due at the Council office on September 15, 2011, November 15, 2011 and January 16, 2012.

- It is your responsibility to make all payments in a timely manner. Payment dates and amounts are:

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- A LATE PAYMENT IS GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL FROM THE JAMBOREE TROOP.** A payment is considered late if it is not received and processed by the Alamo Area Council registrar by the close of business on the scheduled payment date. If the payment date is not a normal business day, the payment date is extended to the next business day. If you have a problem with a payment, you must talk to the Scoutmaster **before the payment due date.**
- A non-paid participant will be removed from the jamboree troops and moved to the **bottom of the waiting list.**

REFUNDS

- Your \$250.00 deposit is non-refundable.** The reason for this policy is quite simple. Alamo Area Council is contractually obligated to spend \$195,000.00 on the 2013 National Jamboree. Experience shows that if a participant can withdraw without any cost, the number of withdrawals will increase substantially and will place a substantial cost on the Council or will cause parts of the jamboree tour to be cancelled to make up the financial loss.
- Before July 1, 2011, your deposit is transferable within the Jamboree troop to a new applicant.
- After July 1, 2011, all deposits and payments are non-refundable unless all participant slots are filled. A refund request for the payments you made less the \$250.00 non-refundable deposit will be processed as soon as the replacement participant has paid all payments due at that time.

WAITING LIST

- Initial placement on the waiting list is based upon the date and time of payment of the deposit.
- While you are on the waiting list, you do not have to make any of the scheduled payments other than the initial \$250.00 deposit.
- If you are moved into one of the jamboree troops, you will have thirty (30) days to bring your registration payment current.
- If you do not bring all your registration payments current within thirty (30) days of the notification of your placement in one of the jamboree troops, you will be treated as a non-paid participant and moved to the **bottom of the waiting list.**
- If you are not moved into one of the jamboree troops because all the participants' slots are filled, then your deposit and any other payments you made will be refunded to you after the jamboree.
