

# BEAR CREEK SCOUT RESERVATION

## Off Season Camping Rules & Guidelines

Welcome to Bear Creek Scout Reservation. This reservation permit entitles you to fun, fellowship and practice of the Scouting Spirit. For your protection, the rules are simple, as you will want to return to the same clean facilities many times in the future. What your troop does on the Scout Reservation may determine how the facilities are used by the troops that follow. So treat the camp as your own, as it belongs to all the Scouts of the Alamo Area Council.



Reservations for the use of Bear Creek Scout Reservation should be made at least two weeks before going to camp. To hold a campsite, the permit must have been processed through the Council office and sent on to Bear Creek. The Camp Ranger **WILL NOT LET ANY UNIT CAMP WHO DOES NOT HAVE AN AUTHORIZED CAMP PERMIT.**

The Camp Ranger is on duty and will acquaint units with the location of facilities and rules for use of the campsites.

### RULES AND CONDITIONS FOR CAMPING ON COUNCIL OPERATED PROPERTY.

**RESPONSIBILITY:** It is understood that the acceptance of the permit by the signature of the unit leaders absolves the Council from responsibility for personal accident or property damage suffered by unit leaders and members while on Council operated property.

**ENTERING AND LEAVING:** Observe the arrival time and leaving time as stated on the permit. No one is to enter before consulting the Ranger in any case. Only registered Scouts are admitted. Designated camping areas have been set aside for winter camping and the Camp Ranger will assign you one for your encampment. Please have this reservation form handy for the Camp Ranger. All units must check out with the Camp Ranger before leaving.

**OFF LIMITS:** Dining halls, staff areas, and other building areas are off limits to all campers. The Camp Ranger will enforce this rule and may result in your troop losing its privilege to use Bear Creek.
